

How the hospitality industry is controlling the Corona crisis

About the study

The online job board operator YOURCAREERGROUP, owning the job boards HOTELCAREER, GASTROJOBS, TOURISTIKCAREER and Turijobs, interviewed about 15,000 employees of the hospitality & tourism industry in Germany, Austria, Switzerland, France, Poland, Spain, Portugal, Mexico and a few other (non) European countries about Corona pandemic and its impact on work in tourism in the period from May 4 to May 11, 2020. The results show how the HORECA sector is affected by temporary lay-offs and temporary shutdowns, how the restart is planned and how employees assess the crisis resilience, measures and communication of their employers.

About 900 managing directors, 300 HR employees, 12,900 employees with and without personnel responsibility and 1050 interns / trainees took part in the survey. These results are included in the general overview. Due to rounding, the values may differ from 100%. Percentages below 1% are shown as 0%.






Has your working time been reduced?






Has your company undertaken any initiatives during Covid-19?






As soon as your company's business picks back up again, how long do you think it will take to go back to its usual business activity?

Agreement to the corresponding statements in percent – Comparison company representatives vs. total interviewees






As soon as your company's business picks back up again, how long do you think it will take to go back to its usual business activity?






Which of the following measures should your company take to ensure health protection?






Should your company plan efforts to cope with the consequences of COVID-19?










Does COVID-19 have any long-term negative effects in the following areas?














In case the business is currently shut down: when do you plan to reopen?









How long can your company continue to operate under the current conditions until business operations are threatened?






Do you already have a concrete plan/concept for the return to work or the restart of your business?








Do you already have a concrete plan/concept for the return to work or the re-start of your business?








Which expenses or investments did you have to make because of COVID-19?
